

## **Prof. Dr. Vlado Guberac – Curriculum Vitae**

Prof. Dr. Vlado Guberac was born on August 11, 1965, in Donji Višnjik, Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Since 1993, he has been employed at the Faculty of Agriculture in Osijek, at the Department of Genetics, Plant Breeding and Seed Science. He graduated from the Faculty of Agriculture in Osijek in 1989. He obtained the Master of Science degree in 1993 and the PhD in 1996 from the same Faculty. In the academic year 1987/1988, Vlado Guberac was awarded by the Faculty of Agriculture Council as the best student in his generation. The grade point average within his undergraduate studies was 4.50 of 5.00, and at the master's study 5.00.

In the period 2005-2017, Prof. Dr. Vlado Guberac was appointed dean of the Faculty of Agriculture in Osijek. In 2017, he has been elected rector of Josip Juraj Strossmayer University of Osijek for the four-year term. Since 2017, he is acting as a vice-president of the Academy of Agricultural Sciences. He is also a member of the Parliamentary committee for granting of the state awards for science. Since 2015, he is a vice-president of the Croatian Chamber of Agriculture. Professor Vlado Guberac was also acting as a vice-dean for teaching of the Faculty of Agriculture in Osijek in the office term of 2001-2005. He was appointed to a scientific-teaching title of assistant professor in 1997, to advance to a title of associate professor in 2000, and to obtain a full professor title in 2003. In 2007, he obtained the title of full professor with tenure. During the years 1997, 2004 and 2005, Professor Vlado Guberac realized several study visits in Germany and Austria.

Referring to the study programs of the Faculty of Agriculture in Osijek, Professor Vlado Guberac coordinates several obligatory modules within the scientific area of genetics, plant breeding and seed science. He also coordinated several projects funded by the Ministry of Science and Education, the Ministry of Agriculture and by the local self-government. From 2003-2006, he was an associate in the Tempus project „Reform of agricultural studies in Croatia“ (in cooperation with the University of Hohenheim as a project contractor).

Professor Vlado Guberac has published 76 original scientific papers, eight (8) professional papers, one (1) university textbook, and one (1) manuscript. There are 21 original scientific papers cited in the Current Contents<sup>R</sup> database, and 86 bibliographic citations are cited in the CAB Abstracts<sup>R</sup>. At the national conferences, he presented 52 bibliographic citations, and at international conferences, he participated with presentations of 45 bibliographic citations. He was a mentor of ten (10) doctoral dissertations, nine (9) master theses and 70 bachelor papers. Professor Vlado Guberac is a member of EUCARPIA (European Association for Research on Plant Breeding), of the Croatian Society for Plant Breeding, Seed Science and Plant Nursery, and of the Croatian Society of Agronomists. He is not politically active. He holds a driving license of the following categories: A1, A, B, B+E, C1, C1+E, C, C+E, D, D+E, F, G, M. His hobbies are painting and guitar playing. Professor Vlado Guberac is a Croat by ethnicity, and a Catholic by religion. He is married (wife Marija) and a father of three children (26-year-old daughter Sunčica, 15-year-old son Ante, and 12-year-old daughter Helena).
