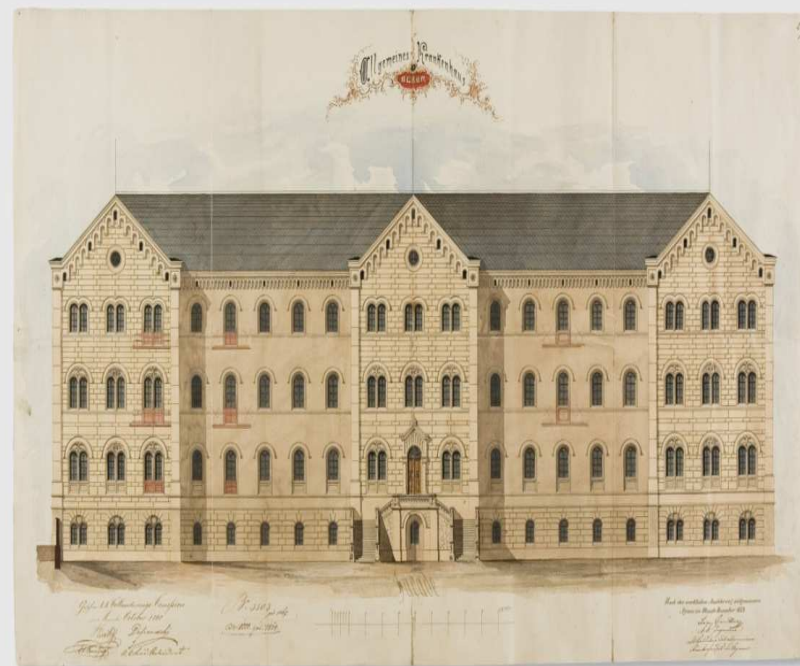

- FACTS & FIGURES AT A GLANCE -

- about 540 doctors of science/year

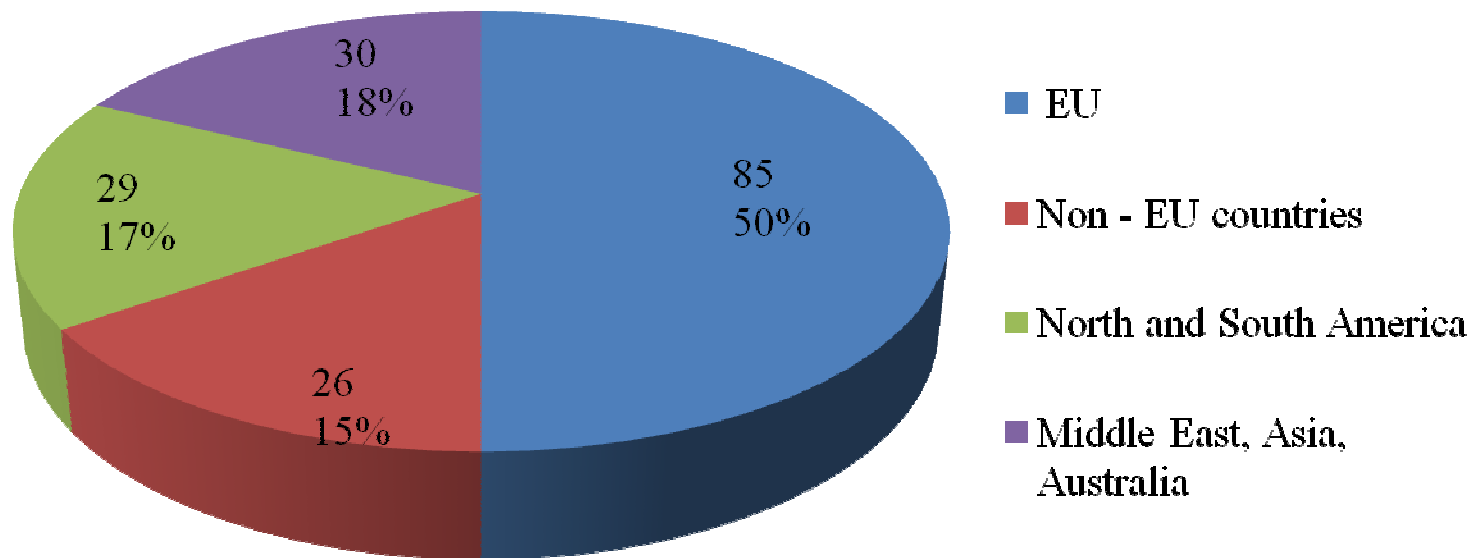

Osijek is the administrative and economic center of Eastern Croatia, situated on the right bank of the Drava River, 25 km upstream from its mouth into the Danube. Osijek is at the crossroads to Hungary, Serbia and Bosnia and Herzegovina, thus being a city of multicultural and multiethnic community.



The University of Osijek (UNIOS) is a modern European higher education institution that acts as a regional center of knowledge, research and excellence. It consists of eleven Faculties, five University departments and one Academy of Arts. It has about 20.000 students and 1500 employees.

Studies are organized according to Bologna principles and ECTS is fully implemented at all levels: undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate level. Covered fields are: natural sciences, technical sciences, biomedicine and medicine, biotechnical sciences, social sciences, humanities and arts. There are also studies within interdisciplinary fields.



There are more than **40 bilateral agreements** signed with institutions of higher education in **European countries**. Multilateral cooperation develops within activities of the Rectors' Conference and is directed towards stronger regional co-operation, organization of joint study programmes and promotion of **Lifelong Learning Programs (LLP)**.

- In 1396 the Dominican general institution of higher education, called UNIVERSITAS IADERTINA, has been founded in Zadar as the first institution of higher education in Croatia
- In 1955, on that basis, the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Zadar was founded, at first as a part of the University of Zagreb, and later as a part of the University of Split
- In July 2002 the Law of Instituting the University of Zadar has been passed by Croatian National Parliament and the reestablished University of Zadar was registered on January 29, 2003
